

FEATURED ARTIST

GINA MIMS

Gina Mims is a California native who relocated from Orange County to Ahwahnee in 2013. Her family has been coming to Bass Lake for their family reunion for over 75 years and on a trip decided it was time for a change. As an art major, she painted often, but as an owner of a graphic design agency, found hectic schedules got in the way. Upon moving to the area, Gina began painting again after an almost 20-year hiatus. She is the owner of Inspiro Brands and works with clients remotely but makes it a priority to paint whenever possible. Gina works with acrylic on canvas, using a combination of both brush and palette knife. She paints as an “escape” and wants that feeling to transcend into her art. Her main desire is to give people who view her work a sense of peace and tranquility. PENNY OTWELL

Motivated by the rhythm and design of the natural world, Penny Otwell chooses to paint where she lives, here in the Sierra Nevada. Living in the mountains profoundly affected Otwell's painting style. Self-taught with a curiosity about geology and landscape, she studied natural history principles through direct observation along the trail and attended scientific outdoor field seminars from experts; what she knows and loves about the mountains is translated into her paintings.

Otwell begins a painting working “en plein air,” occasionally finishing completely in the field. She says her paintings are not a “record” but a manifestation of her feelings about the place or subject while she is there.

“Something about the available light is usually my guide. Over time, I've become a keen observer of nature by painting in the outdoors. Currently I am leaning abstract, the ‘what if’ constantly pulling at my sleeve.”







The Sculpterra estate vineyards reside in the hills of the scenic Linne Valley east of Paso Robles. The 135 acre vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Primitivo, Merlot, Viognier, Petit Syrah, Mouvedre, Pinot Noir, Grenache, Syrah, and Cabernet France. The terrain is clay loam intermixed with gravel beds from nearby streams, reminiscent of the Medoc- Graves region of Bordeaux. The white wines are made strictly in stainless steel tanks. The red wine goes through a complex fermentation process before transfer to oak barrels.





Project “Breathing Life” A Miracle

Rotary is an international club. The Rotary logo is a wheel with many spokes connected in the middle. The key word is “connected” because Rotary International is set up to enable great communication. Sometimes a small miracle happens because of that communication.

The story begins on May 12, 2021, when two global partners joined in the Humanitarian Assistance Initiative “Breathing Life.” They are the Rotary E-Club of Metro Dynamix (Vidya and Prem of Toronto) and the Rotary Club of Coimbatore Textcity in India. (Vidya’s parents live in the town of Coimbatore.) Rotarians in India urged, “As we are fighting the ugly second wave in India, we seek your support in helping the town of Coimbatore breathe. Rotary Club of Coimbatore Textcity is working hard towards providing the ESI Government Hospital with a PSi O2 Oxygen Concentrator to help save lives and supply uninterrupted oxygen to the ones in need.” Meanwhile, Rotary Club of Mariposa Yosemite member Colin Constable’s team member in India knew that Colin would not schedule an early Thursday meeting because of his Rotary meeting. He told Colin about this “Breathing Life” Rotary project he’d heard of. Colin looked up the grant number and contacted Prem Gokul Shanmugam in Toronto, one of the project’s grant team members. In July the Rotary Club of Mariposa Yosemite’s Board voted to send \$2,697 to the Breathing Life project, thus becoming a partner. Eventually, \$137,000 in funds was raised, totally from people not in the Coimbatore Textcity club, but “from people we have never met. Our faith in humanity was restored... We share values of friendship and service.” Recently, along with some Textcity club members, Rotarian Vidya visited the ESI government hospital where the two Oxygen plants are now set up and commissioned to provide uninterrupted supply of oxygen to 40 ICU beds with high flow Oxygen supply. Also, cylinders can be filled and supplied to rural primary health centers when there is a need. With the fear of a third wave (Omicron), it comes as a great relief to city of Coimbatore and the neighboring villages and towns that use and count on this (ESI government) hospital for emergencies. Rotarian Vidya had a brief meeting with the dean of the hospital, Dr. Ravindran, who was very thankful and appreciative of the act of kindness “from fellow Rotarians like you and people from various parts of the world who have made generous contributions towards this project.” He explained how this project will play a vital role in saving many lives irrespective of whether India sees a third wave or not.

This miracle happened because one club voiced a need, and that need was heard by an e-club in Toronto. Our Rotary in Mariposa found out about the project “Breathing Life” thirdhand and got involved. Lives are saved across the world because people listened and cared.


