Rotary in Action

COMMUNITY



Through our Community Giving Project, each year the Rotary Club of Mariposa Yosemite gives between \$6,000 - \$10,000 to local educational, charitable and nonprofit groups in need. During the course of the year, many organizations seek assistance to fund start up costs or operational costs to address human service needs such as Manna House, Heritage House or Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA); to sponsor kids sports teams such as Girls Soccer or Boys Baseball; to fund community events, such as the Bar Associations' Law Day, the Butterfly Festival, and the Story Telling Festival, Mariposa County Trails Day, or the Grizzly Boosters' Sober Grad Night.

In addition, we have helped to fund start up costs for new organizations serving Mariposa County residents, such as Widow/Widowers In Need/W.I.N., the Mariposa County Sheriffs Foundation and the Mariposa Soccer League.

While the traditional vehicle for community giving is through non-profit organizations, we are not restricted in how we allocate community giving dollars. An application is available on-line at mariposayosemiterotary.org. Please read the guidelines and fill out an application to be considered for funding.









Rotary in Action Disaster Assistance



In response to the devastation of the Oak Fire in the summer of 2022, Rotary joined other community organizations as part of an "Unmet Needs Council" to coordinate resources to assist uninsured fire survivors.

Consistent with the Rotary Area of Focus of providing clean drinking water, our Rotary Club allocated its resources towards restoring wells which enabled residents to return to their properties. Tri-County Pump and Well Service provided emergency well repairs in coordination with county-installed trailers, enabling over 20 families to return to their properties.

Our Rotary Club committed over \$27,000 of local resources, and worked with other Rotary organizations to bring in an additional \$30,000 for this effort.









In coordination with the school district, Rotary provides bus shelters throughout the County for children waiting for the school bus. Rotary projects include bus shelter maintenance and sometimes even moving the shelter to a more appropriate place. As we recently discovered, it takes a village to move a bus shelter!

The 135 acre vineyard is planted with Cabernet Sauvignon, Primitivo, Merlot, Viognier, Petit Syrah, Mouvedre, Pinot Noir, Grenache, Syrah, and Cabernet France. The terrain is clay loam intermixed with gravel beds from nearby streams, reminiscent of the Medoc-Graves region of Bordeaux. The white wines are made strictly in stainless steel tanks. The red wine goes through a complex fermentation process before transfer to oak barrels.




