

# Mariposa Rotary Giving Projects (MRGP) Guidelines for Applicants



1. Applicant will complete the Mariposa Rotary Giving Projects (MRGP) application for groups or individuals and families impacted by a natural disaster.
2. Funds are awarded to charitable, educational, nonprofit and not for profit organizations, associations or formally authorized groups, and individuals or families impacted by any local natural disaster.
3. Geographic area within Mariposa County.
4. No funds will directly benefit individual members(s) of any receiving organization as described in the application.
5. The request should start, sustain or complete a specific project or activity.
6. The recipient will provide MRGP a brief written report after the funds have been used for the purposes described in the application.
7. The beneficiary will not use the funds to advocate any sectarian or political viewpoint.

MRGP has monthly meetings. Applications are due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month and applicants will be notified of a decision in writing after the next Rotary Board meeting held the first Tuesday of the month. Notifications are made by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following the Board meeting.
